AIMS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE ASSOCIATION as outlined in our Constitution

- a) To fulfil those needs within the Hastings Community for a non-profit making organisation, representing professional, amateur and student artists.
- b) To establish and maintain in the Community an appreciation of high artistic standards.
- c) To provide an avenue by which those people interested in art can gain information, and to encourage prospective artists, including young people.

 - To benefit worthy causes within the community, as appropriate.
- f) To acquire any rights or privilege to raise funds by any legal means, for the purpose of donating prizes or awards in such terms and conditions as may arise.
- g) To cooperate with other art organizations with similar objectives to disseminate information about art exhibitions.
- h) The income of the Association shall be applied solely for the promotion of the objectives of the Association.

HVFAA GALLERY

The HVFAA Gallery is managed and run by and for our members. The Gallery operates throughout the year on a quarterly cycle basis. This means that every 3 months members artwork is rotated. Members are able to exhibit up to 4 pieces of artwork for a small fee. A 25% commission is taken from works sold to fund the operation of the gallery. If you exhibit works you will be required to be available for a roster to help man the gallery. The gallery is currently open Wednesday to Sunday between 10am to 2pm.

Gallery Art Groups

We have two gallery art groups. One in Port Macquarie and another at Laurieton. These groups are affectionally known as GAGS.
